ALL BRITISH DAY- 2009

Sunday February 8th 2009 URAIDLA OVAL

Held in picturesque village of Uraidla, the South Australian All British Day is now in its 25th year and, from its humble beginnings as a club's family picnic day, it has grown over the years to become the biggest vehicle display of its type in the state. The 750 plus vehicles on display, from South Australia and Interstate, are all members of recognized vehicle clubs and all vehicles are predominantly of British design and manufacture. They are varied and sometimes unique and range from the very oldest to the latest models. All vehicles are parked with their own clubs. This grouping allows interested people to talk to the owners of various vehicles and the progression of models covered by the particular club makes it possible to see how these vehicles evolved over the years

For a large number of entrants, this is the only display at which they show their prized vehicles.

WHAT TO SEE: A fascinating display of stationary British engines will be on show, demonstrating the variety of types of engine and various applications they were used for from before the days of mains electricity. Visit our Trade Display area, featuring Parts suppliers, Restoration products and Automotive Tools. You can also visit the Trade Hall and browse the memorabilia, books and other associated car products that are for sale.

Music will be provided by the "City of Adelaide Concert Band" throughout the day

The adjacent Uraidla Markets will be open with an interesting variety of local produce and other goods for sale.

The featured Club for 2009 will be the Morgan Club of SA - celebrating their 100th Anniversary.

The All British Day Breakfast is worth consideration for early risers as a good start for the day it is held in the Southern Parklands, opposite the Royal Adelaide Showgrounds.

Convenient to the hills it starts at 8.30am and the cars there are a free display worth viewing on its own. Cost is \$7 for a bacon & egg muffin, juice and tea or coffee

The viewing public is most welcome at Uraidla from 11.00 am onwards with free parking available on the attached school oval. Spectator Entry prices are a meagre \$6.00 for Adults and \$4.00 for children aged 6 - 15 years. Overflow parking will be available if required. Please be aware of local parking restrictions on access roads!

CANCELLATION DUE TO EXTREME WEATHER OR EMERGENCIES

Please note that under some circumstances it may be necessary to cancel the event. Examples include extreme weather conditions, severe flooding of the oval and Showgrounds, or a major bushfire in the immediate vicinity.

In the case of cancellation the Committee will do its utmost to notify entrants and potential spectators, but may not be able to notify people individually. Should cancellation be necessary we will notify local radio stations and other media of our decision and in particular ABC Local Radio on the 891 AM band.

PRIZE CATEGORIES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR 2009:-

Shannons Trophy:-
an entered vehicle - chosen on the day.

Shannons Motorcycle Trophy:-
An award for the Best Presented Club - chosen on the day.

President's Lucky Entrant Prize:-
drawn from the Entrants Gate Pass numbers (so make sure you hand your gate pass in as you enter).

ALL BRITISH DAY conditions of entry.

- ➔ **Late Entries. No late entries will be accepted at all.** November 30th postmark will be the cut off date. All entries received after this date will be refused and returned to the sender.
- ➔ **All persons** wishing to enter their vehicle in the All British Day must be a member of a recognised vehicle club. Interstate entries welcome.
- ➔ **All vehicles** displayed must be of predominantly British design &/or manufacture.
- ➔ **Commercial vehicles** displaying advertising for a currently operating business must not engage in trading on the day.
- ➔ **Trade plates** must not be used under any circumstance.
- ➔ **All entrants** must obey the instructions of the Marshals at all times. Failure to do so is an offence under the road traffic act.
- ➔ **NO VISIBLE GATE PASS--NO ENTRY.** Vehicles not displaying a Gate Pass as instructed will be treated as non-entrants and will not be allowed entry.
- ➔ **GATE PASSES MUST BE DISPLAYED FOR THE ENTIRE EVENT** for insurance purposes and to assist the Marshals with any Gate Crasher problem.
- ➔ **Entry time to the Show Grounds** will be 10.00am unless notified with the Gate Pass that is sent out mid January. Entrants are requested not to arrive at the Showground gates until the specified time.
- ➔ **Entrants** must park within their allotted area and are not to encroach onto the roadways or other clubs areas.
- ➔ **All vehicles must be in place by 11.30am** - to allow the viewing public safe access.
- ➔ **All vehicles should remain stationary** on the oval until at least 3.30pm for safety reasons plus ensuring that the viewing public receives value for money and has an ample chance to view the exhibits.
- ➔ **The Marquees** erected on the Oval are for the use of all entrants. Chairs only is the ruling and persons erecting tables will be asked to remove them as others need shelter also.
- ➔ **The eastern gate and roadway** will be **ONE WAY (IN ONLY)** until **12.00noon** to assist the vehicular flow through this narrow gateway.
