ALL BRITISH DAY 2020 ENTRY INVITATION

9am, Sunday February 9th, 2020

Echunga Recreation Grounds. Echunga/Hahndorf Road, Echunga, South Australia

Owners of British vehicles are invited to participate in the annual All British Day vehicle display and picnic at Echunga. To make the day an enjoyable event for all, it is important that you read these Conditions of Entry and Entrant Rules.

ENTRIES CLOSE 5pm on Thursday 7th NOVEMBER 2019

Conditions of entry

- All persons wishing to enter their vehicle in the All British Day must be a financial member of a recognized vehicle club. Interstate Vehicle Club entries are welcome.
- All vehicles displayed must be of predominantly British design.
- Modified British vehicles are most welcome.
- **Commercial vehicles** are most welcome but any vehicle displaying advertising for a currently operating business must not engage in trading on the day.
- Trade plates must not be used under any circumstances.
- No Dogs are permitted at the event. This does not apply to assistance dogs for the disabled.

Guidelines for entrants

- Entry time for Entrants at the Recreation Grounds is 9.00am. Entry prior to this will not be allowed and please do not queue at the gateways and block entry to service vehicles etc.
- All vehicles must be in place by 10.30am to allow the viewing public safe access. The gates will be closed at this point to all vehicles except service personnel, organisers and the disabled.
- All vehicles must remain stationary on the oval until 3.00pm for insurance and safety reasons. This also ensures that the viewing public has an ample chance to view the exhibits.
- Entrants must park within their club's allotted area and are not to encroach onto the roadways or other clubs' areas. Please keep all tents and gazebos within the bounds of your allotted club area.
- No tent pegs or other surface penetrating devices may be used on the Ovals due to subsurface watering systems. If erecting Gazebo type shelters, the cover must be weighted down via cord or rope with a minimum of 10 Kg at each corner, not only weighted at the bottom of the legs. This is a council safety requirement, also applies to large shade umbrellas.
- Due to the rural location of All British Day. We recommend that <u>you refer to the CFS website</u> as to their recommendation regarding the use of gas BBQ's at Echunga
- Cancellation due to extreme weather conditions. In the event of a <u>catastrophic fire warning</u> for the Echunga district or a forecast temperature for Mt Barker given by the Bureau of Meteorology as of 6:00pm the day before the event of 40 degrees or more, the event will be cancelled. If the event is cancelled, sorry, no entry fees will be refunded but memorabilia will be posted out.























EVENT ASSISTANCE

The All British Day Committee would like to thank all those who have helped in the past to make this a great event. There are many opportunities for marshals and volunteers, as listed on the ENTRY FORM. The following is a guide to those interested in being a marshal.

GUIDELINES FOR MARSHALS

Field and Club Marshals are very important in the successful running of your event and all car clubs are asked to assist in these two areas. Clubs are requested to supply at least one Field Marshal and Club Marshals as listed below. These marshals must be legally qualified to direct vehicles. If you would like to qualify, you will need to attend a S.A. Police training session. For session details refer to **Marshall Training** below. Then register your intentions in the Event Assistance section of the All British Day entry form.

Field Marshals. These marshals must be legally qualified to direct vehicles. Some of these marshals will be rostered from 7.30am to sort and direct the entrant and other vehicles into and around the recreation ground and ovals. Some marshals will be rostered to deal with the entrants coming in from 9.00am to 10.30am. At 3.00pm we will also require some marshals to assist with the orderly departure of entrants from the grounds in conjunction with the CFS. The Field Marshal's duties are all quite straightforward and volunteers will be contacted prior to the event.

Club Marshals. These marshals must be legally qualified to direct vehicles. All clubs with more than 8 entrants are asked to supply a Club Marshal. 25 entrants or more requires 2 or more Club Marshals. A Club Marshal's duty is to place their own club's vehicles in the allocated area on the oval. Prior to the event, the Club Marshal will receive an oval layout map, the number of club vehicles to park and the club vehicle spacing. The Club Marshal should arrive about 8:30 am so that their club's vehicles can be parked quickly and efficiently in the allocated area when the gates open at 9:00.

Marshal Training. Friday January 31st 2020. Each year, on the Friday night a week before the event, we hold a Police Marshal Training class. Starting at 7.30pm, it is a short course and will finish approximately 8.30pm. Once you have participated in this training you are a recognized Marshal for life. Well worth the effort as you can then use this qualification for your own club events. Clubs and individuals are invited to attend regardless of participation in the All British Day event and should contact the ABD Committee. (See the contact details below)

ALL BRITISH DAY BREAKFAST

The All British Day event does not open until 9.00am. Why not join many other motoring enthusiasts at Mylor Oval for the ABD breakfast? Held at Mylor Oval from 8.00 A.M to 10.00A.M How about getting as group from your Club, or a group of your friends to meet at Mylor Oval only 8Km up the road from Echunga, The All British Day Breakfast Includes:

In consideration of acceptance of this entry to attend the 2020 All British Day, the applicant releases the organisers and the organizing clubs of any and all liability for loss, damage, or injury to the applicant, their party, and/or their vehicle. The entrant, by participating in this event, and the passengers, by taking part, shall waive the right or action at law against the organisers, the committee, associated organisers, their representatives, or agents for loss, damage, or injuries arising from attendance at this event.

The Privacy Act 1988 and National Privacy Principles

The All British Day Committee collects the personal information entrants provide and stores it in a database to enable communication with you before the All British Day. Entrants' consent for the All British Day Committee to keep details is implied, unless the committee is notified in writing that your consent is withdrawn. Entrant's name/driver's name and vehicle details (make, model, and entry no.) and your vehicle club will appear in a printed program available on the day. Your details may have been included on a past entrant's database. If you do not enter next year's event, your details will remain on our database. If you would like your details removed, please provide this request in writing to the All British Day Committee.

Under <u>NO</u> circumstances will your information be sold or given to any external agencies for any purpose. By signing this entry form, I acknowledge that I have read and understood the information provided to me by the All British Day Committee, and agree to these terms.
